

## Brendan Dick Chair, Board of Directors Pacific Blue Cross Coquitlam, British Columbia

Brendan Dick is chair of the board of directors for Pacific Blue Cross and a member of the board of the Blue Cross Life Insurance Company of Canada. He was formerly the director of pensions and benefits for the Hospital Employees' Union and the coordinator of the Enhanced Disability Management Program for the Facilities Bargaining Association.
