Wright served eight years as an elected school trustee in St. Albert, retiring from her board position prior to the October 2021 election. She holds a B.A. degree in political science from the University of Victoria and completed two years of graduate studies in political science at the University of British Columbia. She has a Pension Plan Administration Certificate and an Advance Trust Management Standards (ATMS[™]) Certificate of Achievement. Wright is a graduate of the Rotman School of Management's Directors Education Program (DEP) and holds an ICD.D designation from the Institute of Corporate Directors.
