After years as a higher education administrator and consultant for nonprofit organizations nationwide, Dr. Barbara Burgess-Van Aken earned her Ph.D. degree at Case Western Reserve University. Her research interests include early modern women writers (particularly playwrights), Shakespeare and higher education pedagogy. Her book, a bilingual translation of Barbara Torelli's 1587 play *Partenia*, won the Society for the Study of Early Modern Women's 2014 award for best critical edition. As a lecturer in the English department at Case Western Reserve, she teaches courses on a wide range of topics that draw on her earlier career in the nonprofit world as well as her literary research interests. In addition, she has been a facilitator for Reflection Point (formerly Books@Work) book discussion sessions that offered through the auspices of the university's wellness program since 2010.
