Chris Campbell is the vice president, Toronto Carpenters' Union Local 27 as well as director of equity, diversity and inclusion with the Carpenters' District Council of Ontario. He has been a member of the Carpenters' Union for 32 years, including 17 years as a Business Representative. Campbell has focused his career on creating career pathways into the skilled trades for women as well as Black, Indigenous, and People of Colour. In his role with the CDCO, Campbell's key responsibilities involve building a more inclusive workforce by inviting workers who are underrepresented in the construction industry to join the union. Campbell leads via the example of activism, participating in marches and anti-racism protests on the streets of Toronto. A graduate of George Brown College's School of Apprenticeship and Skilled Trades, he sits on several boards in the community and construction industry, among them the Toronto Community Benefits Network, the Coalition of Black Trade Unionist Canada and the Toronto Crime Stoppers.
