Dr. Kathleen Cartmell is a health services researcher with a focus on dissemination and implementation of evidence-based strategies for increasing use of vaccinations and tobacco cessation. Most of her research focuses on developing and testing interventions to optimize vaccination (Covid, HPV) and tobacco cessation at the health system and community levels. Dr. Cartmell also conducts research in India and Kenya, designed to optimize the delivery of palliative care in low resource settings.
