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Richard Chagnon is a clinical psychoeducator with more than 40 years of experience in organizational health, crisis intervention, trauma response and psychosocial support. He currently serves as Leader, Organizational Health Services at GreenShield, where he coordinates organizational health mandates, trauma response services, psychosocial support initiatives, consultation assignments and guidance for managers facing complex human-impact situations.

Richard taught crisis intervention at the graduate level at Université de Sherbrooke from 2004 to 2020 and led his own consulting company, providing training and coaching in trauma response, mental health, conflict management and team development. He has contributed to the advancement of his profession through the Ordre des psychoéducateurs et psychoéducatrices du Québec (OPPQ), where he served as an inspector and held appointments on the disciplinary council, board of directors and executive committee. Richard has also delivered numerous sessions on crisis intervention, suicide prevention, post-traumatic stress and workplace support.
