

## André Choquet, CIM, FCIA, FSA Director Millani Montréal, Québec

André Choquet is a director at Millani, an environmental, social and governance (ESG) advisory firm, where he contributes to strategic projects for corporate and investor clients by sharing his knowledge and expertise in capital markets, investments, climate-related risks and ESG. He conducted climate scenario analysis for a multi-strategy alternative asset manager and a mining company and led the Semi-Annual ESG Sentiment Study of Canadian Institutional Investors the last three times it was conducted, gathering and analyzing views from up to 37 major asset owners and managers representing over \$6 trillion in assets under management. André is immediate past chair of the Climate Change and Sustainability Committee of the Canadian Institute of Actuaries (CIA) and was recently awarded the CIA's 2022 President's Award for his dedication to furthering the integration of climate-related risks and opportunities into the practice of the Institute's 6,000 members. He was lead author of the 2022 International Actuarial Association research paper on the application of climate-related risk scenarios to asset portfolios.
