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Dr. Robin J. Dunn is an associate professor in the department of kinesiology at Saint Mary's College of California and is the coordinator of the health promotion emphasis. She teaches health promotion courses, such as Community Health and Multicultural Health and Wellness. In January 2019, Dr. Dunn was the co-instructor for a travel course to New Zealand, focused on using natural resources for physical activity to promote and bring awareness to the use of existing surroundings for various modes of physical activity available to everyone. Her research interests focus on using physical activity to develop responsibility and prosocial behaviors in young children and physical activity in girls. She has published in journals such as the *Journal of Teaching in Physical Education* and *Journal of Physical Education, Recreation, and Dance*. Dr. Dunn has a secondary interest in diversity and inclusive excellence and has a recent publication in the *Development and Learning in Organizations* journal. She has presented her work at numerous international, national and regional conferences. Dr. Dunn has a multidisciplinary background with a B.S. degree in business administration with an emphasis in finance from San Francisco State University; an M.S. degree in exercise science from California State University, East Bay; and a Ph.D. from the Ohio State University with an emphasis in physical education teacher education and cognate in youth development.
