

William J. Einhorn Trustee Wayne, Pennsylvania

William J. Einhorn serves as a trustee of the Pennsylvania Employees Benefit Trust Fund, a trust providing health benefits to 70,000 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania public sector employees and their dependents. He is also a trustee of the Teamsters Health and Welfare and Pension Trust Funds of Philadelphia and Vicinity as well as the Newspaper and Magazine Employees Union and Philadelphia Publishers Pension Plan, which together provide medical and retirement benefits to more than 25,000 active and retired individuals and their families. He has a wealth of experience with, and has developed particular expertise in, every aspect of employee benefit administration and has frequently lectured to various employer and employee groups on these issues. For more than 26 years, Einhorn served as the administrator of the Teamsters Health and Welfare and Pension Trust Funds of Philadelphia and Vicinity, as well as president of Administrative Service Professionals, a regional third-party benefits administration firm. After retiring from those positions, he now serves as a member of several boards of trustees of various employee benefit trusts, is a member of the board of directors of a private real estate investment trust, consults with several organizations on various benefit fund matters, serves as an arbitrator in both interest and grievance arbitration matters, routinely testifies as an expert witness in various types of litigation matters, has served as a court-appointed independent fiduciary, is a licensed insurance producer in four states and chairs two investment advisory boards. Prior to joining the Philadelphia Teamsters Funds as a full-time employee, he actively practiced law for several years, specializing in labor relations and ERISA in a firm that represented over 60 Taft-Hartley trust funds. Einhorn received both his B.A. and J.D. degrees from Temple University in Philadelphia. He is a member of various local groups involved with employee benefit issues. Einhorn has served the International Foundation of Employee Benefit Plans as a voting Member of the Board of Directors for several threeyear terms as well as Chair of the Administrators Committee, Chair of the Health Care Management and Coalition Committee and a member of numerous other Foundation committees.
