Douglas Forrester has been a leader in both business and public service in New Jersey for more than 40 years. He is currently chairman and CEO of Integrity Health, which manages large employer health plans using the patient-centered, medical home platform, Partnership Health Centers. Previously, Forrester founded and was the CEO of BeneCard Services and Heartland Fidelity Insurance Co. For many years, he was consulting director for public practice issues for Aon/ASA Consulting and a senior lecturer at the Fels Center of Government at the University of Pennsylvania. He also has lectured in public policy courses at The College of New Jersey as well as Monmouth and Rutgers Universities. In addition to his business career, Forrester served in Governor Tom Kean's administration as assistant state treasurer and New Jersey's director of pensions, during which time he managed the state's seven pension systems and its million-member health benefits plan. Forrester also served as mayor of West Windsor, New Jersey and was a Republican nominee for United States senator and governor of New Jersey. He is the founding chairman of Rising Tide Capital, a 501(c) 3 micro-enterprise and business development organization for economically marginalized populations operating in six New Jersey cities and three other states. As well, he has been involved with various civic and charitable organizations. Forrester has degrees in philosophy, government and divinity from Harvard University and Princeton Seminary.
