Murray Gold serves as counsel to Koskie Minsky LLP's pension and benefits practice. Gold has also been actively engaged in pension reform studies and initiatives. In 2008, he was one of four expert advisors to the Ontario Expert Commission on Pensions. In 2015, he was appointed as one of three initial members of the board of directors of the Ontario Retirement Pension Plan Administration Corporation. Gold also served as the only lawyer on Ontario's Pension Asset Advisory Panel. He is currently engaged with institutional investor fiduciary obligations as a climate expert with the Canada Climate Law Initiative (CCLI). Gold is a fellow of the Ontario Teachers' Federation and is also a member of FSRA's Public Sector Plans Advisory Committee. He graduated from Harvard University with an A.B. degree and from the University of Toronto Law School. Gold is also the recipient of the 2021 OBA Pension Award for Excellence in Pension and Benefits Law.
