Nathan Gonzales is the editor and publisher of *Inside Elections with* Nathan L. Gonzales, which provides nonpartisan analysis of campaigns for Senate, House, governor and president. In addition to publishing *Inside Elections*, Gonzales is also an elections analyst for *CQ* Roll Call. He offers audiences some of the most detailed electoral forecasting in the business. On Election Night 2016, Gonzales was an onair analyst for *Newshour* on PBS after working as an off-air consultant for ABC News on their Election Night Decision Desk for 14 years. Previously, he was an editor, analyst and writer for The Rothenberg Political Report for more than 13 years before taking over the company in 2015. Additionally, he worked for CNN as a political analyst and as an associate producer for Capital Gang. Gonzales has appeared on NBC's Meet the Press and NBC Nightly News, C-SPAN's Washington Journal, NPR's All Things Considered, Fox News Channel and MS-NBC, and he has been quoted in *The New York Times*, the *Washington* Post, the Wall Street Journal and USA Today. His work has also appeared on FiveThirtyEight and NBCLatino.com as well as in Campaigns & Elections magazine. Gonzales earned his master of arts degree from The George Washington University's Graduate School of Political Management (Washington, D.C.) and his bachelor of arts degree from Vanguard University (Costa Mesa, California). He first came to Washington, D.C. as an intern in the White House Press Office.
