Anna Kinghorn is a research coordinator with 14 years of experience developing and implementing workplace wellness interventions. Since 2009, Anna has worked for Dr. Evanoff's lab at Washington University School of Medicine in St. Louis in survey development, community engagement, data collection and intervention implementation. Through this work, Anna has formed partnerships in a range of industries to identify barriers to workplace wellness and implement sustainable changes. Anna has coordinated five federally funded research studies on suicide prevention and opioid abuse and is currently implementing an adapted MATES in Construction training program in the St. Louis area. Since 2019, Anna has regularly provided her expertise to the local construction industry's Suicide Prevention and Awareness Campaign, including developing evidence-based Toolbox Talks. She has presented multiple suicide and opioid prevention trainings as well as reported the lab's research findings in academic manuscripts and at national conferences. Anna earned her double bachelor's degree in sociology and women's studies from St. Louis University and her master of science degree in applied health behavior research from Washington University School of Medicine.
