Mike Reed is an accomplished executive research and development leader in the life science and diagnostics industries. During a 20-year career with Osmetech, Beckman Coulter and culminating as the chief science officer for OraSure Technologies, he led the development and commercialization of over 300 products. In 2020, Reed worked fulltime for RADx (Rapid Acceleration of Diagnostics), the diagnostics arm of the U.S. Government's Operation Warp Speed program to combat the COVID-19 pandemic. RADx was chartered to bring point-of-care COVID-19 tests to market to help schools and employers reopen in the fall of 2020, and many of the rapid tests on the market today were supported by this program. He co-founded TestZone in June 2020 to provide turnkey testing, a health screening app and broader health security programs to businesses, schools and government facilities as they grapple with the new realities of life in and after a deadly pandemic. Reed's role as the chief science officer is to create a dynamic offering that remains relevant in this time of great change and to build partnerships with state-of-the-art science and technology companies to include in TestZone's Health Security Platform.
