Dr. Janis Sarra is professor of law at the University of British Columbia (UBC) Peter A. Allard School of Law. She held the position of the UBC presidential distinguished professor from 2014 to 2019, was previously director of the Peter Wall Institute for Advanced Studies at UBC and has served as associate dean of the faculty of law. She was founding director of the National Centre for Business Law and a senator of the University. Dr. Sarra has researched and taught corporate and securities law, banking and finance law, corporate governance, ESG and climate risk management, fiduciary obligation, insolvency law, economics and contract law. She is a member in good standing of the Law Society of Ontario. Dr. Sarra is currently a director on the boards of Assuris, the International Insolvency Institute and the global Commonwealth and Climate Law Initiative. She is a member of the Canadian Delegation to the United Nations Commission on International Trade Law WG V and is principal co-investigator of the Canada Climate Law Initiative. Dr. Sarra has published more than 15 books and 100 publications.
