Miville Tremblay is senior fellow at the C.D. Howe Institute and visiting fellow at CIRANO. He is a regular op-ed contributor to La Presse. Tremblay is involved in the establishment of the Canadian Sustainability Standards Board (CSSB) and played an active role in attracting an office of the International Sustainability Standards Board (ISSB) in Montréal. He was senior director and a member of the Monetary Policy Review Committee of the Bank of Canada as well as a member of its pension fund investment committee. Tremblay started his career as a business reporter, mainly at *La Presse*, before becoming director of strategic intelligence at Caisse de dépôt et placement du Québec. Tremblay is a CFA® charterholder and a former president of CFA Montréal. He is the author of two books on finance and business. He has received the Atkinson Fellowship in Public Policy, the Prix du livre d'affaires PricewaterhouseCoopers and Prix Performance from UQAM business school. Tremblay holds an executive M.B.A. degree from Université du Québec à Montréal (UQÀM), a master's degree in public policy analysis from Laval University and a B.A. degree in political science (international relations) from McGill University.
