Dr. Thomas Young serves as chief medical officer and co-founder of Nview Health, the leading provider of behavioral health assessment technology and suicide tracking. He is a University of Texas Medical Branch graduate, served in the National Health Service Corps and taught at Baylor College of Medicine before moving to Boise, Idaho to join the Family Practice Residency of Southwest Idaho and going into full-time practice. Dr. Young served as a medical consultant to EDS where he developed automated claims analysis technology. He was also the medical director and creator of Idaho's first EMS paramedic program. Following that, he was the medical director for QIO and Idaho Medicaid, during which time he developed the first evidencedbased pharmaceutical management program. As chief medical officer and executive vice president, he led the growth of Connextions Health and its eventual sale to Optum before returning to Idaho and becoming the chief operations officer of a large counseling center for children and families. Dr. Young built Idaho's first APA-certified psychology postdoctoral program and has since served as the medical director for behavioral health clinics and other organizations including U.S. Preventive Medicine and Citra Health Solutions.
